Field Rules Reminders:

- 1) Smoke has been allowed for use at the flying field.
- 2) There is still a 400' ceiling in effect where full scale aircraft are in the immediate vicinity.
- 3) When full scale aircraft are in the air, or if you fly over 400', all pilots must fly with a spotter. (this is an AMA rule.)
- 4) All giant scale pilots must have someone to hold their aircraft while starting.

Please be aware of your surroundings. Help us to have a safe and enjoyable flying season.

My Fellow Members;

I hope that all of you are having a great flying season. Just as a reminder, please come out and support Paul's IMAC event on August 12-13 and Big Jim's Warbird event on August 26th. The club has passed a motion to allow the holiday party this year. A motion also passed for \$500 worth of prizes to be raffled off to club members only at the holiday party.

An exploratory committee was commissioned for the purpose of building a 'clubhouse' at the flying field. Mike Palumbo was appointed the chairperson. Mike is proposing to erect a 30' x 30' steel beam and siding building that will be insulated and will come with windows and doors.

As you may or may not know, the club has a sizable surplus of revenue. A clubhouse would benefit ALL members, not just a few who have a key. All members would have access to the clubhouse when the park is open.

Mike will have several estimates ready for the membership to vote on the proposal during the November general election. The clubhouse would be large enough to hold monthly meetings on the field. It would benefit members in the winter as a warm shelter, and in the summer as a cooling station. Several benches would be built and a new diesel generator would be purchased for electricity.

Lastly, remember to vent your fuel bottles, as the hot summer temperatures will cause the plastic bottles to expand and eventually burst. Have a safe and enjoyable August.

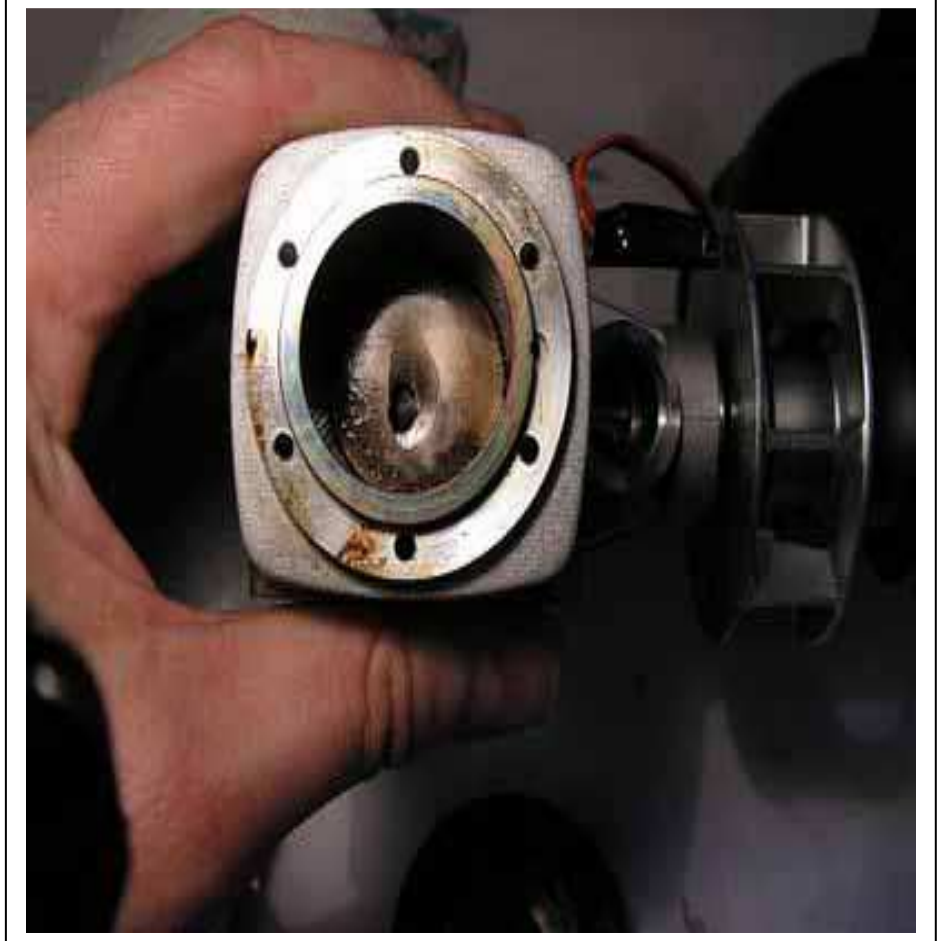
